LABYRINTH

WINDING DOOR MAT

LABRYNTH PATTERN

Mat is crocheted in rows from the center out. Each row starts with 1 turning ch. Each new strip is begun with 1 turning chain then single crochet sts worked along the short end of the previous strips. See diagram for arrangement of strips.

INSTRUCTIONS

BLACK STRIP 1

Ch 21.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across (20 sts).

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across (20 sts).

Pull the loop on the hook to enlarge it and set it aside to be worked later.

WHITE STRIP 1

Work on the other side of the foundation chain.

Row 1: Join the yarn to the first Black ch. Ch 1, sc in each sc across (20 sts).

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across (20 sts.)

WHITE STRIP 2

Rotate the work 90 degrees to the right (clockwise), ch 1, sc across short end of White Strip 1 (3 st), then sc across short end of Black Strip 1 (6 sts total).

Pull the loop on the hook to enlarge it and set it aside to be worked later.

BLACK STRIP 2

Put the Black loop back on the hook, rotate the work 90 degrees to the right and work as for White Strip 2.

Pull the loop on the hook to enlarge it and set it aside to be worked later.

WHITE STRIP 3

Put the White loop back on the hook. Rotate the work 90 degrees to the right.

Row 1: Ch 1, work 3 sc across short end of White Strip, then work 20 sc across the long edge of the Black Strip, then work 3 sc across the short end of the White Strip (26 sts).

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across (26 sts).

Pull the loop on the hook to enlarge it and set it aside to be worked later.

BLACK STRIP 3


Put the Black loop back on the hook, rotate the work 90 degrees to the right and work as for White Strip 3.

Continue to work additional strips in this fashion (see diagram) until the mat is the desired size. The sample has 17 strips.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Wash and dry flat to block if desired.





SKILL LEVEL

Intermediate

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Approx. 22 x 29 in / 56 x 74 cm

MATERIALS

Yarn: CYCA #6 (super bulky/roving) Schachenmayr Bravo Big or equivalent (131 yd/120 m / 200 g)

Yarn Amounts: White #101, 400 g Black #199, 400 g Hook: U.S. size L-11 / 8 mm

Notions: Tapestry needle

Gauge: 9 sc and 10 rows = 4 x 4 in / 10 x 10 cm. Adjust needle size to obtain correct gauge if necessary.
